VOLUNTEER OPTIONS

GREETER--greet guests as they come in the door. Give them information on the school/museum. Answer any questions about the artifacts.

RAILROAD DIORAMA--Greet guests as they enter the train room. Show them the different towns. Run and explain the different trains and the importance of the trains to mining.

GIFT SHOP--Give guests information about the items in our shop. Write up receipts. Take cash or checks. Restock the counters.

ACCESSIONING--Process material donations. Collect, catalogue, record, archive, store and provide accessibility to artifact collections.

OTHER:

EXHIBITS--Designs, produces, and executes all displays of historic artifacts while working in conjunction with the accessioning team.

EVENTS--Assist with planning, set up and break down of events. For example: craft show, yard sale, Creepy Cottonwood and Zeke Taylor barbeque.

NEWSLETTER--Assist writing articles for the quarterly newsletter.

TECHNOLOGY--Assist in all areas of computer technology including training and development and maintenance of equipment.
